

THE CURRICULUM

The assessment will determine the curricular sequence for achieving the set goals. Regardless of course selection, students will be supported by a personal mentor/advisor, experienced faculty, and caring and knowledgeable academic and student service staff.

THE PROGRAM'S GOALS AND EXPECTATIONS

- 3. Prepare students to face the rigors and expectations of the academic culture of American universities by preparing them for a comfortable transition to American life and culture.
- 4. Students may acquire at least fifteen (15) transferable academic credits in an American university.
- 5. Students who complete the US-ACADEMIC PREPARATION can be assured that they will be able and expected to enroll at a competitive and appropriate university in the United States. Students who prefer to tackle undergraduate studies online or whose U.S. visa status is in question will be admitted and can transfer credits earned immediately.
